

INTER-UNIVERSITY BEACH VOLLEYBALL NIGHT TOURNAMENTS REGULATIONS

I. Aim

- 1.1. Raise athletic capabilities among students;
- 1.2. To promote an active lifestyle;
- 1.3. To promote beach volleyball.

II. Time and place

- 2.1. Volleyball tournament will take place on the 4th and the 5th November, both days from 22.00 – 2.00 (10PM- 2AM);
- 2.2. The Games will be held in the Olympic Sports Centre “O-Sands” sports hall (Grostonas street 6b, Riga).

III. Management

- 3.1. The competition is organized by Turība University and National Defence Academy of Latvia

IV. Participants

- 4.1. The competition is open to all students studying in Latvia who love volleyball;
- 4.2. Each team is allowed to apply 2 people;
- 4.3. Women and men are evaluated separately;
- 4.4. In one team all members from the same university;
- 4.5. To participate in the tournament, during registration you must show (student ID / ISIC / certificate).

V. Process and evaluation

1. Game format 2:2
2. Game time: The game takes place up to 21 points or 10 minutes.
3. Game stage play system, the length and the number of sets is decided by the organizers, taking into account the number of teams applied.
4. The teams can be divided into subgroups.



5. Point scoring is following:

5.1. Game won – 2 points, game lost – 1 point, absence – 0 points;

5.2. If two or more teams have the same number of points, the higher place is awarded to the team:

5.2.1. after a total game ratio;

5.2.2. after the game ratio of mutual matches;

5.2.3. after the points in mutual game sets.

VI. Regulations:

Judging– the competition is judged by the organizer appointed referees. In case of a dispute, the decision is made by the main referee.

Discipline – if one of the teams hinders the match more than 5 minutes - It is given a loss.

Game schedule will be developed, depending on the number team's applied.

VII. Applications.

Teams must **send in their applications until November 1st 23:59;**
